⁸ "When evening came, the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Call the workers and pay them their wages, beginning with the last ones hired and going on to the first.'⁹ The workers who were hired about five in the afternoon came and each received a denarius. ¹⁰ So when those came who were hired first, they expected to receive more. But each one of them also received a denarius. ¹¹ When they received it, they began to grumble against the landowner. ¹² 'These who were hired last worked only one hour,' they said, 'and you have made them equal to us who have borne the burden of the work and the heat of the day.' . . . ¹⁶ So the last will be first, and the first will be last." Matthew 20:8-12,16

1. Give thanks for what you _____.

Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever. Psalm 107:1; 118:1; 136:1

2. Don't _____ yourself to others.

We do not dare to classify or compare ourselves with some who commend themselves. When they measure themselves by themselves and compare themselves with themselves, they are not wise. II Corinthians 10:12; Romans 12:13

3. God's _____ doesn't make sense.
