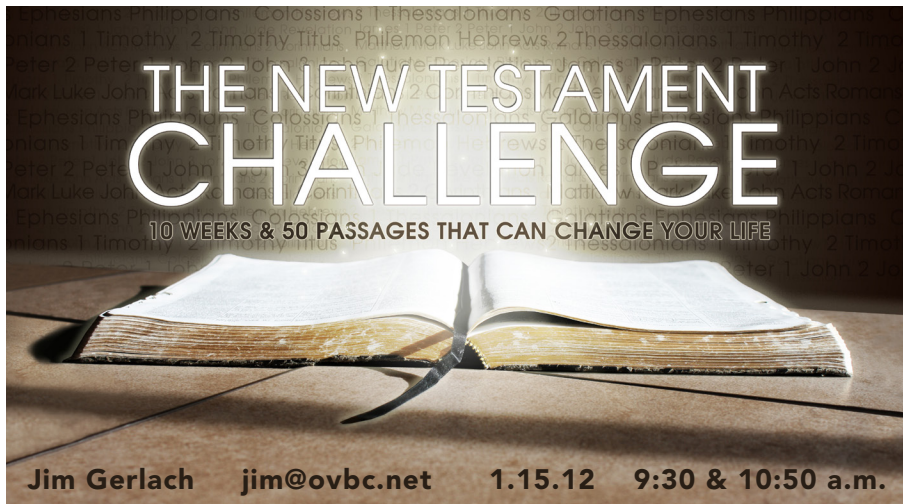




1. The Word of God is supernatural _____.
