*Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil— Hebrews 2:14*

*You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world. I John 4:4*

*And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. Revelation 12:11*
