**Crossing your “Jordan”** - *A journey that requires greater \_\_\_\_\_, provides a new \_\_\_\_\_ and takes us to a place we’ve never been before.*

### 1. Follow the Lord’s \_\_\_\_\_. v. 1-4

<sup>1</sup> Early in the morning Joshua and all the Israelites set out from Shittim and went to the Jordan, where they **camped before crossing over**. <sup>2</sup> After three days the officers went throughout the camp, <sup>3</sup> giving orders to the people: “When you see **the ark of the covenant** of the LORD your God, and the Levitical priests carrying it, you are to move out from your positions and follow it. <sup>4</sup> **Then you will know which way to go, since you have never been this way before.** But keep a distance of about two thousand cubits between you and the ark; do not go near it.”

*Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, “This is the way; walk in it.” Isaiah 30:21*

### 2. Let go of the things that \_\_\_\_\_ God. v. 5-8

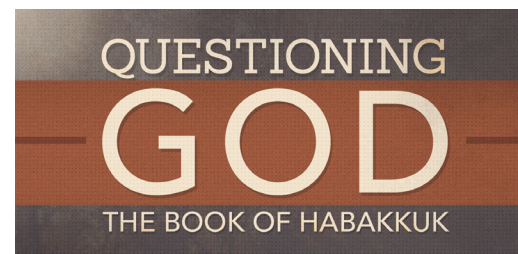
<sup>5</sup> Joshua told the people, “Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the LORD will do amazing things among you.”

*But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. 1 Peter 2:9*

### 3. Step into the \_\_\_\_\_. vv. 9-17

<sup>11</sup> See, the ark of the covenant of the Lord of all the earth will go into the Jordan ahead of you. <sup>12</sup> Now then, **choose twelve men from the tribes of Israel**, one from each tribe. <sup>13</sup> And as soon as the priests who carry **the ark of the LORD**—the Lord of all the earth—set foot in the Jordan, its waters flowing downstream will be cut off and stand up in a heap . . . <sup>17</sup> The priests who carried the ark of the covenant of the LORD stopped in the middle of the Jordan and stood **on dry ground**, while all Israel passed by until the whole nation had completed the crossing **on dry ground**.
